Equations

Examples	Non-Examples
x = 5	5
2a = 16	2 <i>a</i>
3x + 4 = 19	3x + 4
5 = 8x + 3	8x + 3
12 – 7 = 5	12 – 7
$\frac{3}{4}y = 6$	<u>3</u> 4


