

BIG IDEAS GAME CLOSET



Name the Number

Materials: 1 number cube, 1 coin for each group
1 place-value chart for each player

Directions:

Players: 2

1. Each player needs a place-value chart like the one shown.
2. Players take turns tossing the coin. If the coin lands on heads, the players will be looking for the largest number. If the coin land on tails, they will be looking for the smallest number possible.
3. One player rolls the number cube. Each player writes the result in any of the empty place value cells of their chart.
4. Repeat step 3 until all the places are filled.
5. Players read their numbers aloud and compare them.

Who Wins?

The player with the greatest or smallest number (as determined by the coin toss) wins a point. The first player to win 3 points wins the game.
