Top This

● Materials:

- Cards numbered -20 to 20
- 1 coin

● Directions:

Play with a partner. One partner flips the coin to determine the operation (heads - addition, tails - subtraction). The shuffled cards are placed face down in a stack. Each player takes two cards and computes using the determined operation. The player with the lower result takes all the cards from the round. If the result is a tie, each player keeps their own cards.

● Who Wins?

The player with the fewest cards at the end wins the round.

● Variation:

- Deal the cards to each player. Players decide which cards to play to make the lower result.
