Quart = 32 fl oz

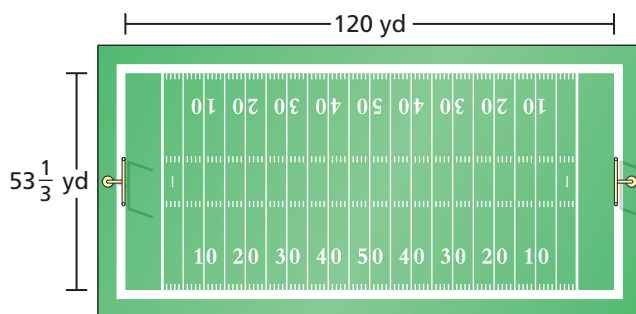
Half gallon = 64 fl oz

Pattern: Each amount after the first is two times the previous amount.

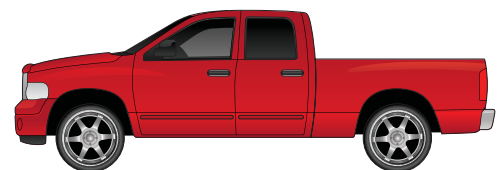
3. **FOOTBALL FIELD** Find the length and width of the football field in feet.
