## Key Concept and Vocabulary

A **sequence** is a series of numbers. Each number in a sequence is called a **term**. You can identify patterns to find missing terms of a sequence.

Each term is 2 more than the previous term.



Sequence:

3, 5, 7, 9, ?, ?, ...  
 $+2$   $+2$   $+2$   $+2$   $+2$

Fifth term:  $9 + 2 = 11$   
 Sixth term:  $11 + 2 = 13$
