Key Concept and Vocabulary

Multiply numerators.

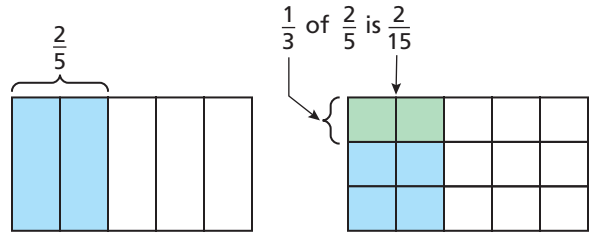
$$\frac{1}{3} \cdot \frac{2}{5} = \frac{1 \cdot 2}{3 \cdot 5} = \frac{2}{15}$$

Multiply denominators.

Multiply fractions.



Visual Model



Skill Examples

- $\frac{2}{3} \cdot \frac{1}{4} = \frac{2 \cdot 1}{3 \cdot 4} = \frac{2}{12} = \frac{1}{6}$
- $\frac{3}{8} \times \frac{2}{9} = \frac{3 \cdot 2}{8 \cdot 9} = \frac{6}{72} = \frac{1}{12}$
- $\left(\frac{2}{5}\right)\left(\frac{1}{4}\right) = \frac{2 \cdot 1}{5 \cdot 4} = \frac{2}{20} = \frac{1}{10}$
- $\frac{1}{7} \cdot \frac{3}{5} = \frac{1 \cdot 3}{7 \cdot 5} = \frac{3}{35}$

Application Example

- A recipe calls for three-fourths cup of flour. You want to make one-half of the recipe. How much flour should you use?

$$\frac{1}{2} \cdot \frac{3}{4} = \frac{1 \cdot 3}{2 \cdot 4} = \frac{3}{8}$$

••• You should use $\frac{3}{8}$ cup flour.

Find the product. Write your answer in simplified form.

- $\frac{1}{3} \cdot \frac{2}{7} = \frac{2}{21}$
- $\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{4} = \frac{1}{8}$
- $\frac{1}{10} \cdot \frac{3}{10} = \frac{3}{100}$
- $\frac{3}{2} \times \frac{2}{5} = \frac{3}{5}$
- $\frac{3}{8} \times \frac{1}{2} = \frac{3}{16}$
- $\left(\frac{1}{5}\right)\left(\frac{2}{5}\right) = \frac{2}{25}$
- $\left(\frac{2}{3}\right)^2 = \frac{4}{9}$
- $\frac{3}{2} \cdot \frac{2}{3} = 1$
- $\left(\frac{3}{1}\right)\left(\frac{1}{3}\right) = 1$
- $2 \cdot \frac{1}{4} = \frac{1}{2}$
- $3 \times \frac{3}{4} = 2\frac{1}{4}$
- $\frac{1}{3} \cdot \frac{3}{4} \cdot \frac{4}{5} = \frac{1}{5}$

Find the area of the rectangle or parallelogram.

- Area = $\frac{1}{4} \text{ ft}^2$
- Area = $\frac{3}{20} \text{ cm}^2$
- Area = $\frac{15}{64} \text{ in.}^2$
- Area = $\frac{6}{25} \text{ m}^2$

22. **OPEN-ENDED** Find three different pairs of fractions that have the same product.

Sample answer: $\frac{9}{10} \cdot \frac{5}{6} = \frac{3}{4}$ $\frac{7}{8} \cdot \frac{6}{7} = \frac{3}{4}$ $\frac{4}{5} \cdot \frac{15}{16} = \frac{3}{4}$
